



Elephant Plains Game Lodge



Elephant Plains Lodge is situated in the northern area of the Sabi Sand Game Reserve, which forms part of the 2,2 million hectare Greater Kruger National Park. Five original rondavels are set in a beautifully landscaped garden. All rooms at this Sabi Sand lodge have en-suite bathrooms with shower, bath and air-conditioning.

You can see Africa's Big Five - Elephant, Rhino, Buffalo, Lion and Leopard. Rare species such as the endangered Wild Dog and Cheetah are also seen regularly.

The highlight of your visit to this Sabi Sands safari lodge is the thrill of discovering wildlife from the safety of open 4x4 vehicles. Your experienced game ranger and local Shagaan tracker are keen to share with you their extensive knowledge and love of the African bush.

Evening meals at Elephant Plains Lodge are served around a blazing fire, in the boma (African grass hut) under the vast African sky. Breakfast and lunch are served buffet style in the thatched lapa. Adjacent to the swimming pool, the wooden deck offers spectacular views overlooking the waterhole and scenic plain.
